In seeking continuous improvement, concern and awareness for the environment will be the responsibility of the senior management and accordingly delegated to all levels of management.

The company recognises that in seeking continuous improvement in environmental excellence, this cannot be achieved without raising awareness and commitment amongst its employees. Therefore, education and training will be provided to all employees to ensure that employees carry out their duties with concern for the environment and in a manner that prevent unnecessary waste, promote where possible recycling of materials, minimise energy consumption, prevent pollution through adequate control of waste and by taking strict measures that avoid harmful discharges. In addition, contingency plans will be developed and where necessary in partnership with other agencies and clients, to respond to any situation on our site or clients sites, which could have a negative impact on the environment.

All contractors working on behalf of the Company are required to adopt environmental standards fully consistent with those of the Company and they are expected to achieve comparable levels of performance as a condition of their conduct.

The company will also keep under review all mandatory rules, regulations, codes, guidelines that are relevant to its operations.
